PRIVACY STATEMENT

The Citizens First National Bank recognizes and respects the responsibility to protect customers' private information. RECOGNITION OF A CUSTOMER'S EXPECTATION OF PRIVACY

The Citizens First National Bank recognizes and respects that our customers expect their financial information to be kept private. The Citizens First National Bank policies guide employees in this important manner.

COLLECTION, RETENTION AND USE OF CUSTOMER INFORMATION

The Citizens First National Bank collects, retains and uses information about its customers only when it would be useful (and allowed by law) in our business or in order to produce products, services, and other opportunities to The Citizens First National Bank customers.

MAINTENANCE OF ACCURATE INFORMATION

The Citizens First National Bank will respond to requests to correct inaccurate information in a timely manner.

LIMITING EMPLOYEE ACCESS TO INFORMATION

PROTECTION OF INFORMATION THROUGH ESTABLISHED SECURITY PROCEDURES

RESTRICTIONS ON THE DISCLOSURE OF ACCOUNT INFORMATION

The Citizens First National Bank does not reveal customer information to unaffiliated third parties for their independent use except when:

- a.) the information is provided to help complete a customer initiated transaction
- b.) the customer requests it
- c.) the disclosure is required by law (e.g., subpoena)
- d.) the disclosure is allowed by law

INFORMATION AND OUR AFFILIATES

The Citizens First National Bank may disclose certain information to its affiliates. The Citizens First National Bank may share transaction and experience information from our account records with its affiliates.

MAINTAINING CUSTOMER PRIVACY IN BUSINESS RELATIONSHIPS WITH THIRD PARTIES

If customer information is provided to a third party, that third party must agree to adhere to privacy principles that provide for keeping such information confidential.

DISCLOSURE OR PRIVACY PRINCIPLES TO CUSTOMERS

WEBSITE

Visitors to The Citizens First National Bank website remain anonymous. We do not collect personal identifying information about site users, unless the user chooses to provide such information. This information is used internally, as appropriate, to handle the sender's request and manage The Citizen's First National Bank website. It is not disseminated or sold to other organizations.

INTERNET BANKING

The Citizens First National Bank contracts its internet banking with Fiserv. Fiserv uses several tools to protect the privacy of personal information supplied or accessed through The Citizens First National Bank's internet banking service. Some of the tools for protection that Fiserv include, but are not limited to:
